



EXEMPTION ORDER OF DIRECTOR GENERAL

12 May 2020

Exemption from the Requirements in Civil Aviation Rule CAR 61, 63, 65, 121, 135 and 137

Pursuant to Provision 8.4 of the Legal Status of Government Agencies Law, Provision 11.1 of the Civil Aviation Law, Resolution No.11 of the State Special Commission, paragraph 103(a), (b), (d) of MCAR-11 and Resolution No.01/20 of the Safety Committee,

I, L.Byambasuren Director of Civil Aviation, being satisfied that:

- the Mongolian Government's restrictions in response to the spread of the virus COVID-19, in particular the increase to emergency of the COVID-19 alert system from 13 March to 31 May 2020, are an event that make the prescribed requirements to renew Mongolian licences and ratings as unreasonable in this particular case; and
- the risk to safety will not be significantly increased by the granting of this exemption,

HEREBY EXEMPT—

Persons who:

- are required by Civil Aviation Rule Parts 61, 63, 65, 115, 121, 125, 135 and 137 to maintain currency of their licences and ratings including those operating overseas under foreign authority validation; and
- have a flight review, proficiency check or rating that expires between 5 March 2020 and 1 October 2020

FROM—

- Civil Aviation Rule Parts 61 - 61.17, 61.157, 61.207, 61. 257, 61.307, 61.361, 61.657, 61.707, 61.717, 61.727, 61.737, 61.757, 61.807, 61.907;
- Civil Aviation Rule Part 63 - 63.25;
- Civil Aviation Rule Part 65 - 65.405(b)(3)(ii), 65.455(b)(3);
- Civil Aviation Rule Part 121 - 121.607, 121.609, 121.611;
- Civil Aviation Rule Part 135 - 135.453, 135.455;
- and other such rule parts prescribing the currency requirements for licences, ratings and operational competency,

FOR A PERIOD OF—

From the original date of expiry of the licence, rating or operational competency assessment to 1 October 2020 within which period the privileges of that licence, rating or operational competency assessment may continue to be exercised

PROVIDED THAT—

Every person to whom this exemption applies still satisfies the recent flight experience requirements of CAR 61.37 and CAR 61.807(2)

AND—

To assign Deputy Director B.Altantsom to take relevant measures to monitor and implement of this order.
