Exemption from the requirement of MCAR

In accordance with paragraph 4 of Article 8 of Law on Legal Status of Agency of Government, paragraph 1 of Article 11 of Law on Civil Aviation, Government Resolution 178 of 2020 on “Declaring Nationwide Emergency State”, Mongolian Civil Aviation Rules Part 11.103 “Drafting Rules and Exemption of Requirements Set by Rules” and Resolution 10/20 of Safety Board of Civil Aviation Authority issued on 8 December 2020, the Director General of the Civil Aviation Authority of Mongolia issues the following order set for:

1. The license and certificate holders shall be exempted from the requirement to maintain the English language proficiency exam specified in Part 61 “Pilot’s License and Rating” section 61.11(b) and Part 65 “Air Traffic Service Personnel Licenses and Ratings” section 65.13(2) until 8 March 2021;
2. With respect to this exemption, the Aviation Safety Oversight and Regulatory Department (Urantugs. B) and the National Civil Aviation Center (Munkhjargal. P) are responsible for taking the necessary steps to meet aviation English language proficiency requirements before March 8, 2021 for holders whose a validity period for language proficiency test is expired.
3. Deputy Director General, Mr. Altantsom. B shall be assigned to supervise the implementation of this order.
